WILDLIFE IN west Tennessee is alive and flourishing. Your trip begins in a more relaxed setting along the boardwalk of the Wolf River. Located in Collierville, TN, the **WC Johnson Park Nature Trail** is home to natural vegetation and wildlife habitats. Spend the day here sightseeing, fishing or just enjoying the outdoors.

Continue your traveling to Stanton, TN and **Hatchie National Wildlife Refuge**. Directly north-east from Collierville, the Hatchie National Wildlife Refuge promotes birding, fishing, hunting and natural wildlife viewing along the Hatchie River and O'Neal Lake. With more than 11,000 acres of natural beauty, this park offers plenty of activities for visitors to explore for a day or more.

Spend an entire day (or two) in the **Tennessee National Wildlife Refuge** bicycling, birding, boating, fishing, horseback riding, hunting or natural wildlife viewing. This refuge is located on the Kentucky River in Camden, TN.

#### WC Johnson Park Nature Trail
